At 14:00hrs on 15/02/17 a member of the Port Waratah civil maintenance team unlocked the sound wall gates to access the rail corridor on Sunnyside Street, Mayfield. As he pushed the left hand gate open, the right hand gate hinges gave way and the gate collapsed onto the ground, missing the team members shoulder by a few millimetres and landed by his right boot about 100mm away.

How serious could the outcome have been?

High: there was a credible potential for a death or serious injury to have occurred

Low: any other occurrence or event

What action(s) has been taken / could be taken to address this issue?

Work Group leader and area Manager informed.

Barricade off open access with orange mesh and star pickets to rail corridor to prevent members of public wandering onto tracks.

Fencing contractor engaged to fit 1800mm chain link fence across open access until gate can be re installed.

Get maintenance crews to inspect hinges on all sound wall gates and rectify any defects.

Initiate a routine maintenance schedule for gate inspection/greasing of hinges.
