## Rail Industry Worker Safeworking Competencies - Victoria

This is to notify ARTC staff and contractors that the following competencies in the Victorian safeworking roles will be switched to mandatory on **1 June 2017**:

- TLIF2082 Perform handsignaller duties
- TLIF2081 Perform lookout duties
- TLIF3083 Conduct track protection assessment
- TLIL3065 Implement track occupancy authority (TOA, Track Warrant)
- TLIC2081 Pilot rail traffic within work on track authority limits
- TLIL3083 Implement a track work authority and manage rail traffic through worksites (TWA, Track Force Protection)
- TLIL3084 Implement a local possession authority
- TLIL4069 Plan and coordinate protection for multiple worksites within limits of a work on track authority
- TLIC2054 Access rail track to run track vehicle within defined worksite
- TLIC0084 Access rail track to travel track vehicles under manual block working conditions
- TLIF3058 Apply safeworking rules and regulations to rail functions

All associated roles will be switched to working towards should you not have completed the above competencies by June 1 2017.

For competencies linked to Bulletin 45, the transition date of 1 September 17 still applies.
