NSW Network Rules and Procedures Amendments

Training Requirements

<u>General</u>

ARTC will introduce changes to the Network Rules and Procedures on Sunday 23rd February 2020.

All affected Rail Safety Workers who undertake work or operate on the ARTC NSW Network are required to complete training in the changes by 22nd February 2020.

Affected Rail Safety Workers who do not undertake and complete the training by 22nd February 2020 will not be permitted to operate on the ARTC Network.

Affected Rail Safety Workers (Employees and Contractors) who do not undertake and complete the training by 22nd February 2020, your Rail Industry Worker (RIW) Safeworking role will be deemed invalid, until such time as the training is completed.

ARTC Employee and Contractor RIW Safeworking roles impacted by the changes and time frames for training are shown in the following table:

Rail Industry Worker (RIW) Role	Training Time frames
Network Controller	1 day
Terminal Coordinator	6 hrs
Handsignaller Level 1	3 hrs
Handsignaller Level 2	6 hrs
Protection Officer Level 1	4 hrs
Protection Officer Level 2	8 hrs
Protection Officer Level 3	1 day
Protection Officer Level 4	2 days
Track Vehicle Operator	6 hrs
Safeworking Level 1	4 hrs
Safeworking Level 2	1.5 days
