Upgrade of 416 Points

To be read in conjunction with Train Alteration Advice (TAA) No 0046-2020

General

Commencing at 0600 hours on Tuesday 22nd of September 2020 to 2030 hours Thursday 24th of September 2020, or until the works are completed, the following infrastructure upgrading works will be undertaken at Maitland.

The existing 416 points crossover from the Down Main to the Up Main and associated equipment will be booked out of use and permanently removed. A new 416 points swingnose crossover will be installed and booked into use, as detailed below:

- 416A Points will be located at 193.303km (Up Main)
- 416B Swingnose crossing will be located at 193.332km (Up Main)
- 416C Swingnose crossing will be installed at 193.339km (Down Main)
- 416D Points will be located at 193.368km (Down Main)
- A new four key EOL will be installed on the existing MD248 Location (193.427km).

Testing of the signalling infrastructure at Maitland will involve route setting activities, signal aspect testing and point movements.
