

SAFE Notice 372

LEAST RICHMOND — BOURKE STREET PEDESTRIAN CROSSING (SYDNEY SIDE) TEMPORARY CLOSURE

From Monday, 16 November 2020

As advertised in Weekly Notices 45 - 2020 and 46 - 2020 the pedestrian warning equipment Sydney side of Bourke Street Level Crossing at East Richmond will be temporarily booked out of use and pedestrian access to the Sydney side of the crossing will be prevented.

From Monday, 16 November 2020, prior to any work being undertaken which will affect the Sydney side Bourke Street pedestrian crossing at East Richmond, the pedestrian crossing MUST be:

- fenced off to prevent access
- booked out of use.

Handsignallers will NOT be in attendance at the Sydney side Bourke Street pedestrian crossing at East Richmond.

In exception to NGE 206, it will NOT be necessary for Drivers of rail traffic to be CAN warned whilst the Sydney side Bourke Street pedestrian level crossing is booked out of use, and pedestrian access prevented.
