

SAFE Notice **2021** **103**

ASHFIELD – CENTRAL – CITY INNER – CITY OUTER – NORTH SYDNEY – LINDFIELD

From Friday, 1 January until Monday, 11 January 2021

In conjunction with Special Train Notice No. 0092 – 2021, the following Safeworking arrangements will apply:

ADDITIONAL SAFEWORKING ARRANGEMENTS

TRACK POSSESSION NO.1

In exception to NWT 302, a worksite with associated rail traffic may be established on the Up Shore line at North Sydney within 500m of the LPA limits in accordance with the site safety plan and the following:

Prior to a worksite being established, the following additional possession protection must be provided:

- An authorised Signal Engineering Employee must book out of use the following signals;
 - NS324 SH – Up Shore
 - NS326 2R – No.2 Platform Road.
- Unless required for rail traffic movements to enter or depart the LPA, 605A Points must be clipped and locked in the Reverse Position.
- STOP BLOCK Up Shore line (North Sydney End)
 - A STOP Block painted white and fitted with a red flag and a red light must be fixed to the Up Shore line at approximately **4.957km**.
 - Note:** When it is necessary for a work train, track vehicle or plant to enter or depart the possession, it will be permissible for the STOP Block to be removed to allow the movement. Immediately after the work train, track vehicle or plant has entered or departed the possession area, the STOP Block must be re-secured to the line.
- An additional Worksite Protection Marker must be placed at approximately **4.897km** and additional Railway Track Signals (RTS) placed at approximately **4.897km**, **4.917km** and **4.937km** on the Up Shore line.
