General Details / Operating Condition:

Commencing 0001hrs on Sunday 15 January 2023, ARTC will introduce amendments to the ARTC NSW Network Rules ANTR 430 Train Operating Conditions (TOC) Waiver, ANWT 316 Track Vehicles and the Glossary. A summary of the changes is provided below.

ANWT 316 Track Vehicles

The Rule has been amended with the removal of reference to Train Operating Conditions (TOC) Manual and insertion of reference to ARTC Procedure EPP-32-01 Track Maintenance Vehicle Registration and Operation or Track Maintenance Vehicle Register as applicable.

ANTR 430 Train Operating Conditions (TOC) Waiver

The Rule has been amended with:

- the removal of reference to Train Operating Conditions (TOC) Manual and insertion of reference to Route Access Standard (RAS) or Rolling Stock Standards as applicable.
- Replace Qualified Worker with Competent Work.

Glossary

The Glossary has been amended to include the following new terms inclusive of definitions:

- Rolling Stock Standard
- Track Maintenance Vehicle Register
- Track Maintenance Vehicle Registration and Operation.
