**General Details / Operating Condition:**

Due to work required to be undertaken being less than 500m from the Limit of the LPA on the Kooragang Arrival Roads the following altered Safeworking arrangements will apply.

**Safeworking Arrangements:****Additional Details:**

In exception to ARTC Network Rule ANWT 302 Local Possession Authority and Procedure ANPR 700 Using a Local Possession Authority, due to the worksite being less than 500 metres from the end limit of the Local Possession Authority, it will be permissible to work within 500 metres of the limit of the Local Possession Authority without a Work on Track Authority adjoining the end limit as detailed in this SAFE Notice.

Prior to any work commencing within 500m of the LPA limits at the PWCS/ARTC interface boundaries at the Arrival Roads on Kooragang Island, the Possession Protection Officer must liaise with the PWCS Works Supervisor and obtain an assurance that the PWCS Notification Of Rail Track Possession Permits have been acknowledged and issued to the PWCS Works Supervisor by the Kooragang Network Controller.

The Possession Protection Officer and PWCS Works Supervisor must then come to agreed arrangements regarding worksite protection. After agreement has been reached, the Possession Protection Officer must then advise the worksite Protection Officer of the agreed arrangements and give permission for the work to start. The PWCS Notification of Rail Track Possession Permits must be held for the full duration of the ARTC works.

**Note:** PWCS will be performing various works adjacent to the LPA and will have Rail Track Possession Permits which will overlap the LPA limits on the PWCS Arrival Roads.

At the completion of the work the Protection Officer must advise the Possession Protection Officer that the work is completed. The Possession Protection Officer must then advise the PWCS Works Supervisor.

Recipients must ensure this Notice is circulated to and understood by all personnel affected by, or needing to know, its content.

This Notice must be issued to all affected Competent Workers.

Competent Workers who receive this Notice must follow the requirements.
